

FISK REPORT CATEGORIES

- 1 **PATRIOTIC HOLIDAY PROGRAMS**: Should reflect activities generally associated with Patriotic Observances. In addition to those listed, you might log patriotic pageants, parades, and so forth, It is not limited to only those items listed.
- 2 **AMERICAN LEGION YOUTH PROGRAMS**: Is meant to cover Youth Programs such as flags for first graders, veteran appearances in schools, drug programs for children, etc. If it involves children, it belongs here
- 3 **EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICE**: Refers to Education and Community projects. It might includes items such as city proclamations, school programs, public flag disposal ceremonies, etc.
- 4 **AWARDS/VETERAN ACTIVITIES**: This is a big one you will use most often. It pertains to Awards and Veteran Activities. To be included are such items as attendance at Legion, VFW, DAV, VVA, Purple Heart, Pearl Harbor Survivor, 40/8, Bingo (and other veteran) meetings and socials since they all promote the American Legion tenets and purpose. Perhaps you assist your Auxiliary in the distribution of poppies, or assist a veteran's widow in some way, or man a recruiting booth. Nearly any activity a member participates in while wearing the Legion cap is considered "Americanism" if nothing more than by virtue of displaying and promoting The American Legion emblem and for which it stands. Just remember to log the activities.
- 5 **ADMINISTRATIVE & ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES**: Much time and money is spend in preparing reports, obtaining information, planning, counseling, discussion, etc., in support of our many programs. These activities should rightfully be reported and recognized as an integral part of our operation. Do not overlook this important aspect of Americanism.

HOURS This looks simple and it is. It is meant to include all the time spent in support of the programs of each category and is to include travel time to and from the various functions. We spend a lot of time on the road just to get to our 'job' and accordingly, should receive credit.

MILES Since we are on the road a lot putting many miles on our vehicle, we should get some credit for the wear and tear on the vehicle, not to mention the stress on the driver and occupants. Anytime you travel to and from an Americanism activity in you privately owned vehicle, the miles traveled should be logged in this column.
